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Montgomery Regional Airport passenger traffic increased 25 percent in October

MONTGOMERY, Ala. – Passenger traffic at Montgomery Regional Airport increased five of the last six months compared to 2013. July through October saw double-digit growth, with an October increase of 25 percent.

Based on airport figures, travelers increased 19 percent year-over-year in July; 14 percent in August; 23 percent in September; and 25 percent in October. October achieved two records: the highest single monthly traffic since June 2012, and the highest October traffic since 2005.

“The last few months are good news not only for Montgomery, but also for our partners,” said Montgomery Regional Airport Vice President of Air Service Development Chip Gentry. “A double-digit increase in passenger traffic benefits our concessionaires, rental car agencies and our airline partners.”

“The continuous growth of Montgomery Regional Airport is a result of our commitment to raise awareness of the importance of using the airport,” said Montgomery Regional Airport Executive Director Phil Perry. “It is an essential component of economic development throughout the River Region.”

As Alabama’s capital city airport, Montgomery Regional Airport (MGM) is focused on maintaining pace with Alabama’s and the River Region’s economic growth. Montgomery Regional Airport is served by American Airlines with daily nonstop service to Charlotte, N.C. and Dallas, Texas and Delta Airlines with daily nonstop service to Atlanta, Ga.
